

D. To increase our income so that we can continue to develop what we offer to the parish and increase what we give to the diocese.

How?

Hall Income.

Continue to grow the income of the Hall by increasing its usage throughout the week and during school holidays;

Charitable trust fundraising.

Put together a small team to develop our fundraising from charitable trusts and corporates on specific projects e.g: Church organ repair; sound system improvements; tree pruning and maintenance; Church repairs in line with Quinquennial Report recommendations; Hall repairs and any agreed development of Hall facilities;

Regular donors.

Increase the number of regular donors by keeping in touch through a biannual newsletter with those:

- Who no longer live in the Parish but who wish to be kept informed of ASNE activities;
- Families who have been part of a christening, confirmation, marriage or funeral service held at ASNE;
- Families who have plaques dedicated to loved ones in our Memorial Gardens;

Fundraising Events.

Continue to build on the success of the annual October/November fair/table-top event held in the Hall;

One-off donations.

Continue to sensitively encourage donations at key annual services of worship and other events such as christenings, weddings, funerals, Asian/African festival;

Legacy fundraising.

Implement a programme of legacy fundraising by regularly including relevant information through the biannual newsletters, the website, on our notice boards and by creating a How You Can Help fundraising leaflet.

Website.

Review and where appropriate update website content and photos and expand fundraising section.
